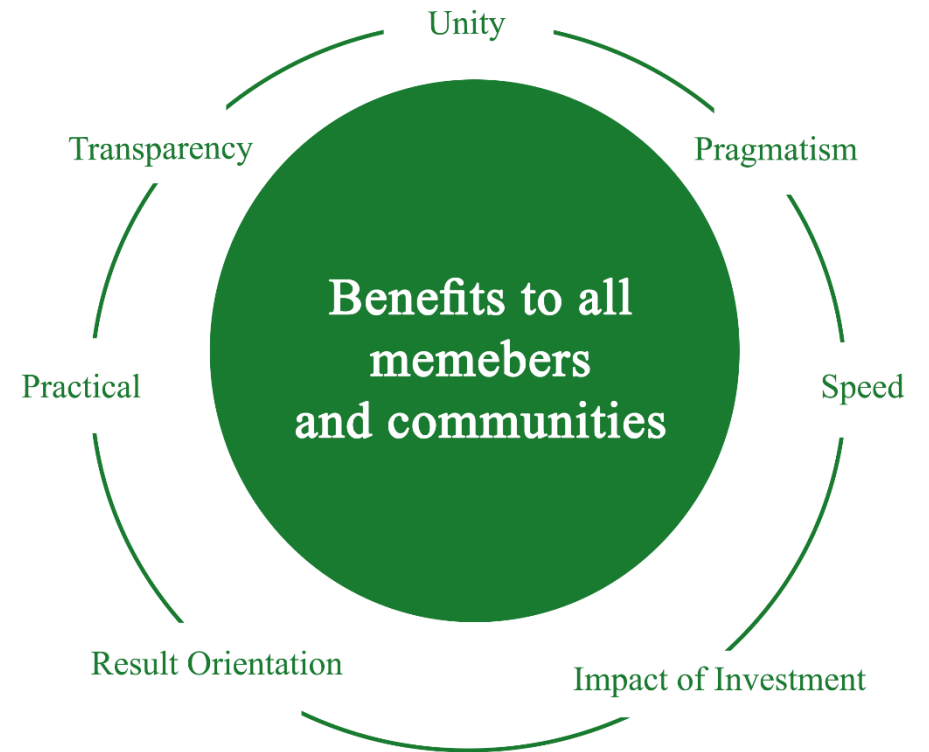
MISSION
